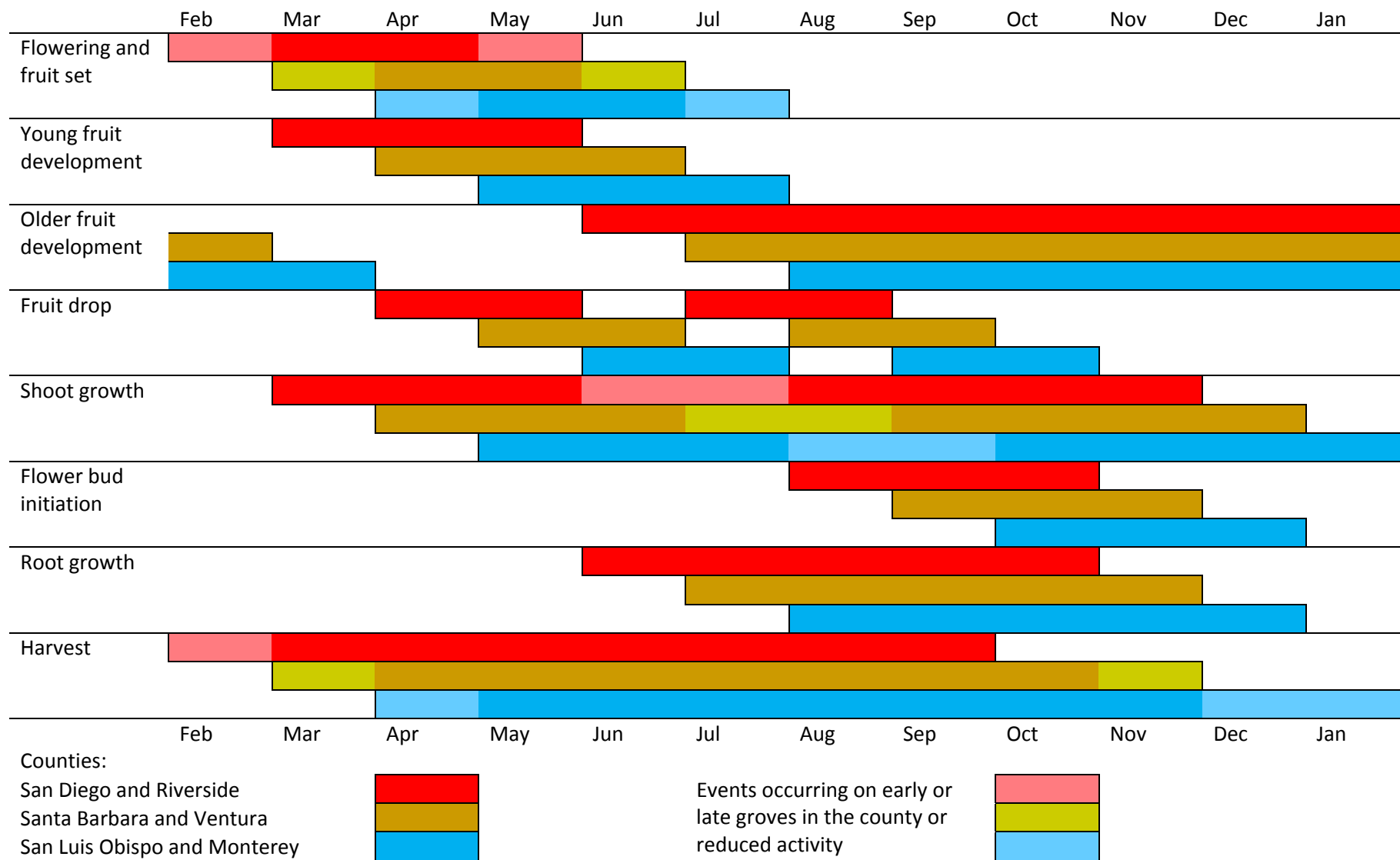




The average seasonal phenology of avocado trees, typically of the Hass variety, across a single year for the main growing regions in southern California. Individual trees and groves may be earlier or later than the average, and the precise timing of phenological events depends on a number of factors, including: cropping history of the trees, the cultural-management practices used on the grove, prevailing weather conditions and harvesting decisions.
