#### Item #1: CALL TO ORDER

Finance Committee Chairman Jason Cole called the meeting to order at 3:01 p.m. with a quorum present.

#### **Item #2: PUBLIC COMMENT**

None

#### Item #3: MINUTES

The Committee reviewed the minutes from the June 23, 2022 meeting and the following motion was offered:

MOTION: The Finance Committee approves the June 23, 2022 Finance

#### Item #4A: 2021-22 FINANCIAL UPDATES

The Committee reviewed the 2021-22 Financial Statements as included in the June 23, 2022 Finance Committee Packet. Discussion ensued and the following points were made:

Monica Arnett highlighted that revenue is continuing to trend higher than
originally budgeted due to higher than anticipated pricing. CAC originally
budgeted \$1.25 per pound and the season to date average through June is \$1.77
per pound and July averaging \$2.10 per pound.

 Ms. Arnett reminded the Committee that the results of the CAC grower and handler late-season crop survey indicated an updated volume estimate of 270 MM pounds, which is 30 million pounds lower than management's original estimate. Even with this reduction in volume, strong early season pricing combined with a significant beginning reserve balance will offset any potential shortages.

The <u>2021-22 Financial Update Packet</u> is attached to the permanent copy of these Minutes as identified as Exhibit A.

#### Item #4B: CASH DISBURSEMENT AUDIT

The Committee reviewed the disbursement registers for June and July 2022 as included in the Finance Committee Meeting Packet with no significant comments to note.

#### Item #4D: RESERVES POLICY RECOMMENDATION

The Committee reviewed CAC's fiscal year-end operating reserves policy as included in the Finance Committee packet. Ms. Arnett commented that the reserves policy was established and approved by CAC's Board of Directors in 2016 as a recommendation by CDFA to all commodity boards and is reviewed annually by the Finance Committee in conjunction with consideration and approval of the annual budget.

Ms. Arnett explained that the targeted minimum fiscal year-end reserve balance would be equal to six months of average operating costs, or an amount not less than \$5 million dollars, and is intended to provide funding for organizational costs from the beginning of the fiscal year to first receipts of sizable assessment revenue. The calculation of average monthly operating costs includes all recurring expenses such as administrative and contracted professional services and incorporates estimated Marketing program expenses and research project costs. Additionally, the reserve balance will help mitigate the imprecise nature of production estimates made prior to the start of a season, which directly affects revenue projections, and to avoid utilizing borrowed funds from the line of credit.

After discussion the Finance Committee agreed that the current policy is reasonable and should not be adjusted for the 2022-23 fiscal year.

#### Item #4E: 2022-23 BUDGET AND ASSESSMENT RATE DISCUSSION

Discussion regarding the 2021-22 budget and assessment rate began with Ms. Arnett presenting CAC's current financial position and projected ending reserve balance for the 2021-22 fiscal year. The calculations presented estimated that the 2021-22 crop size would total 270 million pounds with forecasted revenue of \$14.3 million and ending reserves of \$10.6 million, assuming an average price of \$1.30 for the remainder of the season. This ending reserve balance would be \$250 thousand higher than the original 2021-22 projection, which includes \$990 thousand of unspent funds being returned to reserves.

Ms. Arnett presented a suggested assessment rate and budget for the 2022-23 fiscal year which proposed an assessment rate of 1.75% based on a 250 million pound crop at an average price of \$1.25 per pound. Projected total budgeted expenditures would be estimated at \$14.7 million with \$9.5 million allocated to the Marketing department. This level of spending would result in a 2022-23 ending reserve balance of \$7.9 million.

The Finance Committee reviewed and discussed various crop, price per pound and budget scenarios as well as revisiting the assessment rate determining that the high level of reserves should be reduced. The Committee discussion considered the current economic inflationary conditions and an elevated market along with ever-increasing grower costs. The Committee also discussed various budgeting strategies focusing on utilizing a fixed total Marketing budget per pound to determine what the overall Marketing budget should be.

The Finance Committee agreed upon a recommendation to the Board of a significantly reduced assessment rate of 1.00% for 2022-23 with the expectation that it will increase back to 1.75%, or a more historically average rate, in 2023-24. The Committee also agreed upon an overall budget of \$13 million, allocating \$7.75 million to Marketing based on a Marketing budget per pound of \$0.31 and a 250 million pound crop.

#### **Crop Statistics**

Handlers reported 271.1 million pounds of California avocados were harvested through August 2022 with an average price (per pound) reported at 1.78 dollars. An estimated 2 million pounds were harvested in September 2022 with an average price (per pound) of 0.90 dollars. This would bring the total harvested through September 2022 to 273.1 million pounds at an average price (per pound) of 1.77 dollars.

The attached year-to-date 2021-22 U.S. Aggregate Avocado Volume by Month Chart shows the actual crop volume for all countries of origin with prior year comparison.

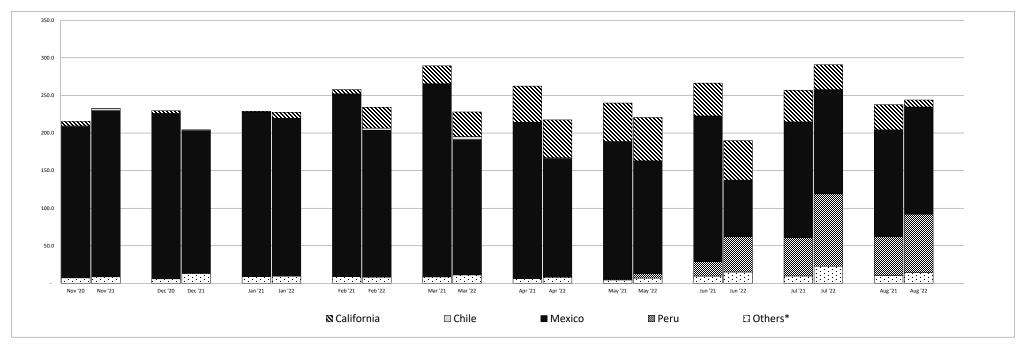
